### Dress Code

- Students will adhere to HMSA uniform policy while on campus.
- Only the HMSA uniform sweatshirts or jackets may be worn by students while on campus.
- Students who are out of dress code will not be allowed to attend class until the issue is resolved. The time missed due to a dress code violation will count as missed class time.

### Skateboards/Bikes

- Students may not ride their skateboards or bikes on any part of the HMSA campus.
- Bikes must be walked to the bike racks found between building A and C.
- Skateboards must be carried to the skate racks found between building A and C.
- These items may not be stored inside of any school building.
- Any violation of these policies will result in confiscation of item and loss of the privilege of bringing item to school.

### Absences/Tardies

- Students are expected to be present and on time to every class meeting.
- Students who miss more than 8 hours of class time over the course of the 3 week semester will be dropped from the class.
  - o First Semester – July 6, 2009 – July 24, 2009
  - o Second Semester – July 27, 2009 – August 14, 2009
- Students who are tardy more than 5 times (excused or unexcused) will be dismissed from summer school.

### Log Entries

- Students receive log entries for failure to uphold their part of the student compact (failure to produce quality homework, failure to be prepared with said materials, etc)
- Log Entry Consequences
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> Log Entry in Semester – Parent Conference
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> Log Entry in Semester – Dismissal from Summer School
- Sample Reasons for Log Entries
  - o Incomplete or No Homework
  - o Dress Code Violation
  - o Failed Test, Quiz, or Exam
  - o Class Disruption
  - o School Policy Violation
  - o Chewing Gum while on School Campus

### IPODS/MP3 Players/Cell Phones

- Ipods/MP3 Players
  - o These devices are only permissible on common grounds before and after school. Confiscated music players will be returned only after student performs community service to the school.
- Cell Phones
  - o Possession of cell phones is permitted only on an out of sight and out of sound basis. Students are not allowed to use their personal cell phones on campus at any time. All cell phones should be turned off. Any student who contacts parent/guardian using personal cell phone will be held to consequences of using cell phones during school hours. Confiscated cell phones will be returned only after student performs community service to the school.
